Calvert Library appreciates donations of books, movies and audios that are in good, clean condition. We accept 3 bags or boxes at a time.

Current items are especially appreciated.

Due to space restrictions, we will not accept encyclopedias, computer books, and textbooks over two years old.

To donate items, please bring them into the building during library hours, and ask a librarian where to leave them. Please see a librarian before leaving books. A book cart can be made available.

A donation receipt form is available upon request. The library does not keep a copy nor place a value on donated materials.

After reviewing donated items, librarians or volunteers will decide whether to add the items to the library collection, to sell at the Book Sale, or to recycle.
