

# Using the Rosetta Stone App—Free with your library card!

To begin, install the **Learn Languages: Rosetta Stone** app for your device. It's available in the Apple App Store, Amazon App Store, or on Google Play.



Then, before launching the app, create a Rosetta Stone account on the library website.

1. Go to [smrla.org/rosetta](http://smrla.org/rosetta).
2. Complete the 3 question form.
  - A. Email Address
  - B. Password
  - C. Language to learn
3. Click Sign In.
4. Click to open the app (sample link below).

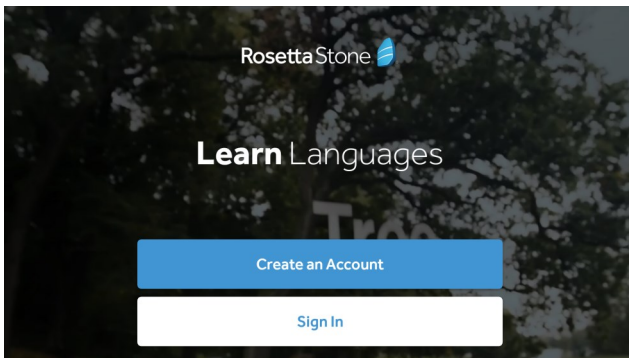
