

Paper Tube Alligator



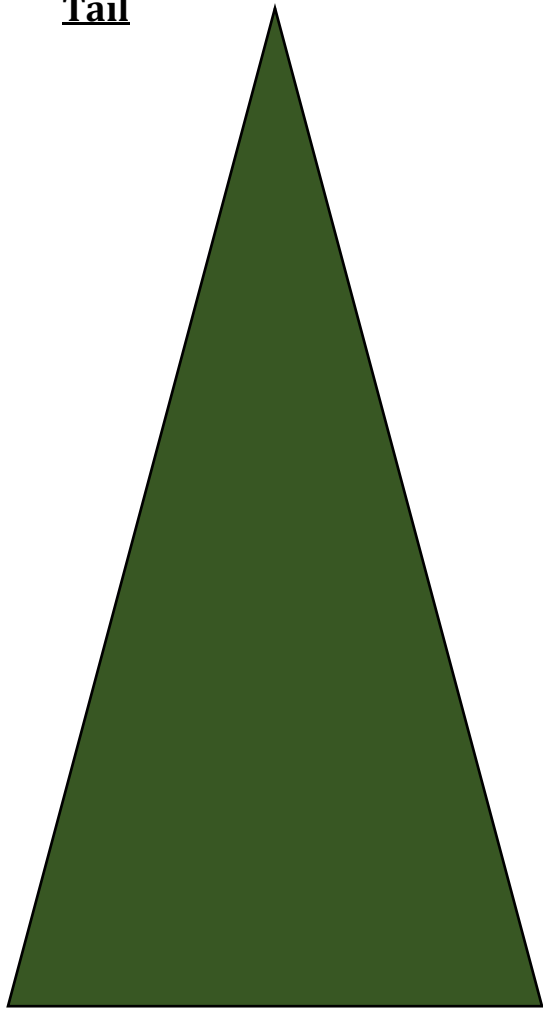
Supplies:

- 4 to 6 toilet paper tubes, depending on how long you would like your alligator
- Construction paper or white paper
- Scissors
- Markers, crayons, or paint
- Glue or tape

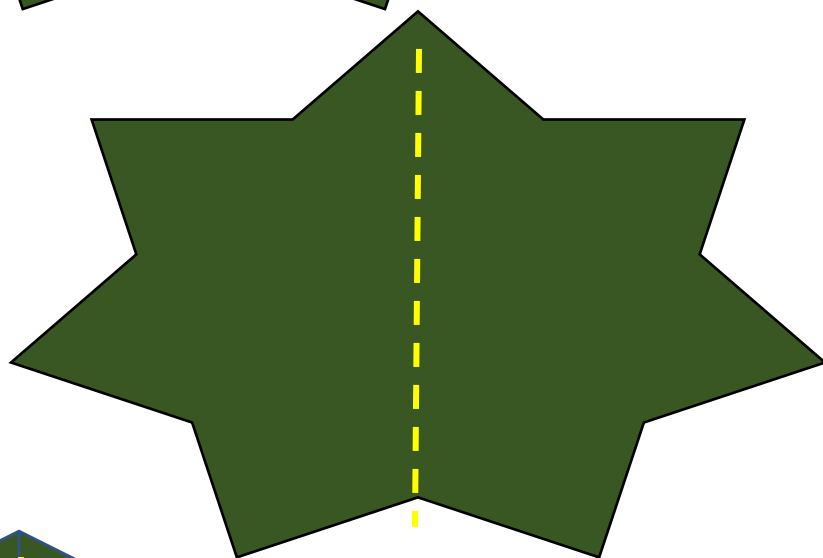
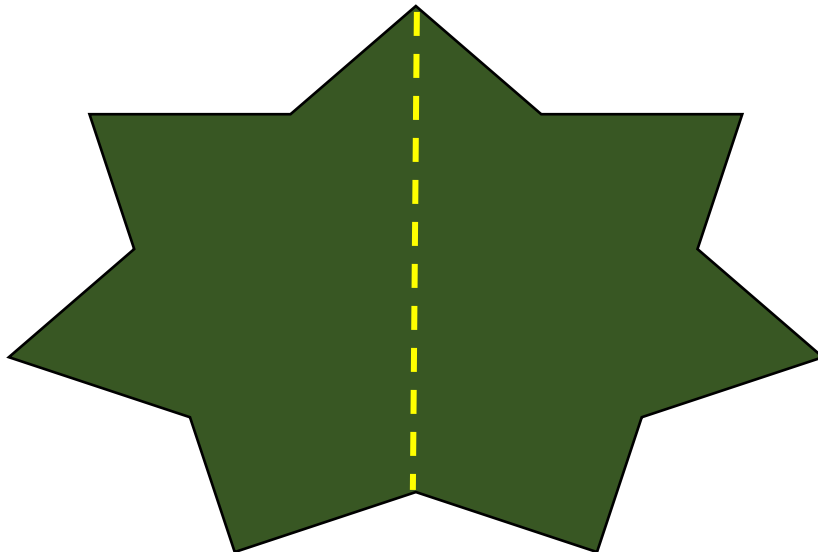
Instructions:

1. Cut out the template pieces out of construction paper or white paper if would like to color the pieces yourself.
2. Join your paper tubes together by laying them side by side and then glue or tape them together.
3. Fold head piece in half at dotted line. Then, cut out a strip of triangular teeth (make then as big or small as you want!) and add to the inside edge of the mouth.
4. Add eyes to your head – draw them on, use button, pompoms, wiggly eyes or anything that you would like for the eyes.
5. Add the legs, tail and head as shown in the photo above.
6. Decorate your alligator however you like – make it colorful or realistic.
7. Name your alligator and proudly display it for your family to admire.

Feet – need 4 so cut these in half at dotted line to make four feet
