THE QUESTIONS:

Answer: False; snakes do smell with their nose, but they can also pick up scent chemicals with their tongue.

- * Wrong answer Action: Put out your tongue like a snake -- in and out. Now you can say hi in "snake" language
- 2. Choose the correct answer: Snake tongues are forked so that they can... a) Scare predators and look mean; b) Locate which direction scents are coming from; c) Hiss until they pass out; d) Lick their favorite food- ice cream!

Answer: B

- * Wrong answer Action: Quack like a duck
- **3. True or False:** A Chameleon is a reptile but a turtle is not.

Answer: False- both are reptiles – they have scales, are cold blooded, lay eggs.

- * Wrong answer Action: Name a reptile_____
- **4. True or False:** Mammals have hair. Name your favorite mammal _____

Answer: True

- * Wrong answer Action: Mimic an elephant
- **5.** Choose the correct answer: Snake venom can be used to make... a) Medicines; b) yummy smoothies; c) paint; d) Glue

Answer: A

- * Wrong answer Action: "Wave your hands in the air and wave them like you just don't care!"
- **6.** True or False: All spiders are venomous.

Answer: True; all spiders use venom to kill and consume prey

* Wrong answer Action: Yell "AHHH Spiders!!!"

7. True or False: Macaws can live to be over 80 years old!

Answer: True macaws can outlive humans.

* Wrong answer Action: Squawk like a parrot

8. True or False: Alligators are better swimmers than runners.

Answer: True

- * Wrong answer Action: Whistle three times
- **9. True or False:** Male chameleons are usually more colorful than females.

Answer: True; this may attract girlfriends, similar to some bird species such as cardinals

- * Wrong answer Action: Touch your nose, touch your head, clap three times while skipping
- 10. True or False: Turtles and tortoises can climb out of their shells if necessary.

Answer: False; their shells are attached to the spine and rib-cage so they cannot climb out.

* Wrong answer Action: Name your favorite turtle? _____

11. True or False: Hedgehogs can shoot their spines out over distances of almost 6 feet into a predator.

Answer: False; hedgehog spines are permanently imbedded in the skin and cannot be ejected.

- * Wrong answer Action: Eat all your vegetables at dinner tonight
- 12. Name the difference between poison and venom.

Answer: Poison is *ingested* [by eating it, inhaling it, absorbing it through the skin, drinking it, etc.].

Venom is *injected* into the bloodstream by a stinger, barb, or fangs.

- * Wrong answer Action: Act like a monkey!
- **13. True or False:** The Great White Shark has the strongest bite of any animal on the planet! **Answer:** False, crocodiles and alligators have the strongest bite of over 3000-5000 lbs of pressure per square inch!
 - * Wrong answer Action: Bite your brother or sister -- *JUST KIDDING* -- we meant blow a kiss to your brother or sister or parent!
- **14. Bonus questions:** Group discussion for these very important questions...
 - -Who is your favorite animal at ECO?
 - -What are some things you can do to help our planet EARTH? Each person name two.
