FROM THE DIRECTOR

What an exciting year it has been for Calvert Library! You read and listened to a lot as a community during the last fiscal year! For the first time since the pandemic, our circulation is back over 1,000,000! Your digital checkouts of music, e-audiobooks and e-books were up a whopping 62%! We continued working on our Steps to Anti-

We continued working on our Steps to Anti-Racism goals. Customer Expectations were revised to be clearer and less subjective. We rewrote our Equity Statement, instituted a Feedback Form process for staff and updated a number of Staff Handbook policies to remove subjectivity.

In April, we opened the new Twin Beaches Branch in North Beach, and the community's enthusiastic response has been overwhelming. On opening day alone, we welcomed 1,316 visitors, and in just three months, we recorded 35.847 customer visits -3,000 more than in all of FY23. Our staff has efficiently created new library cards, averaging 500 per month. Spanning 18,000 square feet, the new library enhances community services with features such as 24/7 pick-up lockers, a fully equipped makerspace, a sound booth, a memory lab, over 25 public computers, versatile community gathering spaces, exhibit areas, an Imagination Station play area for toddlers and teen gaming station. This project showcases the power of collaboration between government, non-profit organizations and residents which has created something truly special. Here's to another year of building community at your public library!


Calvert Library Mobile Services visited 1,258 childcare providers, homebound customers, neighborhoods, community partners and special event locations this year.




