Cultivate Curious Minds

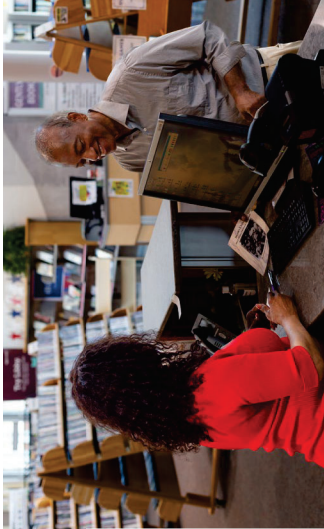
- Engage families and caregivers in high -quality early learning programs that build foundational skills
